Exceptional scholastic achievement and leadership in campus activities won for University of Minnesota, Morris freshman A. David Hedine, Glenwood, the first Dean's Award, to be presented annually to the outstanding UMM student.

Hedine, son of Dr. and Mrs. A. C. Hedine of Glenwood, was influential in many aspects of student life as well as maintaining high scholarship throughout the year.

He was active in the provisional student government and in revising the constitution of the student government. He served as president of the Lutheran Student Association and was active in the total campus religious program, assisting in Clergy Day and religious convocation plans.

A member of the Radio Club, Hedine participated in the daily UMM radio program broadcasts over KMRS, Morris. He also served as vice-president of Morris Players, the campus drama group.

An administrative committee and a committee of students studied qualifications of candidates for the Dean's Award with the final choice of recipient of the Award being made by Rodney A. Briggs, Dean.
