The appointment of James B. Togeas as instructor in organic chemistry at the University of Minnesota, Morris has been announced.

The assignment is one of twenty-one new faculty appointments now being made which will bring the total to thirty-five full-time faculty members in September. UMM opened last fall with a freshman class of 238 students and is now being expanded into a four year liberal arts college.

Mr. Togeas formerly taught at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis and is now a National Science Foundation Fellow. He received his bachelor of arts degree from S. Olaf College, Northfield, Minnesota, and is completing work for his master's degree at the University of Minnesota. He was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, national honor society at St. Olaf.
