The appointment of Dr. Clyde E. Johnson as assistant professor of music at the University of Minnesota, Morris has been announced.

Dr. Johnson was formerly associate professor of music and chairman of the department of music at Parsons College, Fairfield, Iowa. At UMM he will teach band and instrumental music and music education.

Dr. Johnson received his bachelor of music, master of arts, and doctor of philosophy degrees from the State University of Iowa, Iowa City and studied for one year in Germany under a Fulbright scholarship.

The composer of many instrumental compositions, Dr. Johnson is a member of several professional societies. He is married and has three children.

Dr. Johnson's assignment is one of twenty-one new faculty appointments now being made following the Minnesota legislature's approval of funds for the continued operation of the University of Minnesota, Morris. UMM opened last fall with a freshman class of 238 students and will add sophomores this fall and juniors the year after.
