BRITISH COMEDY TO OPEN UMM FILM SERIES

Two of Britain's most talented actors star in "The Titfield Thunderbolt" which will open the 1961-1962 film series at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

Stanley Holloway and John Gregson are featured in the humorous story of an ancient single track railway and its fight for survival against replacement by a modern busline. The British comedy will be shown to subscribers of the film series at 8:30 p.m. on Monday, October 9 in Edson Hall at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

This season's film series will offer 12 films, four shown each quarter. Tickets may be purchased at the UMM Business Office or at the showing of the first film on Monday evening. General admission tickets are \$2.00 for the fall quarter series of four films or \$5.50 for a season ticket for all 12 films.

Following "the Titfield Thunderbolt" on the fall program are a French drama, "Forbidden Games", on October 30; a British comedy, "Lucky Jim", on November 13; and a Russian film, "Ballad of a Soldier", on November 27.
