#### UMM ARTIST COURSE TO PRESENT BALLET ENSEMBLE

Theatre-goers in West Central Minnesota will be treated to a delightful and different evening next Tuesday, November 21, when the Zachary Solov Ballet Ensemble will appear in Morris in the second University Artist Course program.

Presented by famed impresario , S. Hurok, the stylish troupe will begin their performance at 8 p.m. in Edson Hall Auditorium on the University of Minnesota, Morris Campus. Season tickets for this program and the remaining events in the 1961-62 Artist Course Series are still available at a reduced price. Write the University or call 371.

Choreography for the ballet ensemble is by Zachary Solov whose brilliant work at the Metropolitan Opera House has been applauded throughout the Met's season. Now Mr. Solov has trained his own hand-picked troupe to present across America some of his best ballets, ones not in the repertory of any other company.

The ensemble is headed by two of the best-known dancers in America, Irina Borowska and Michael Maule. Costumes were designed by Malcolm McCormick.

The Zachary Solov Ballet Ensemble will be followed in the University Artist Course Series by the Minneapolis Madrigal Singers on Tuesday, January 9. Sir Bernard Waley-Cohen, Lord Mayor of London, will speak on Tuesday, January 30, and the Ceylon National Dancers will appear on Monday, February 26. Henry L. Scott, piano-humorist, will close the series on Tuesday, April 12.

In addition to the above events, season ticket holders will be admitted free to any one of the six UMM Music Department concerts during the coming season.
