The 1961 lettermen and numeral winners at the University of Minnesota, Morris were announced this week by Bruce D. Rolloff, Director of Athletics and head football coach at UMM. Seventeen lettermen and five numeral winners were named on the list published at the end of the first season of inter-collegiate football at the one-year-old college.

Sophomores awarded letters were Warren Enger, Madison, who played end on the team; Craig Erickson, tackle from Morrystown; Donald Sherman, end from Clinton; and Courtland Swenson, tackle from Hoffman.

Freshmen lettermen are Captain Dennis Bakke, guard from Morris; Douglas Duncan of Appleton, who played halfback and end positions; Michael Ellingson, end from Ashby; Michael Fischer, halfback from Fulda; Gerald Grant, halfback from Graceville; James Johnson, halfback from Kensington; Thomas Knutson of Benson, who played guard and fullback; and Ronald Lovehaug of Milan, who played tackle and fullback.

Other freshmen awarded letters were Marshall Nordquist, center from Hoffman; Clayton Risdahl, guard from Canby; Paul Skrien, quarterback from Hutchinson; Stuart Starner of Hoffman, who played quarterback and end; and Jerald Willert, end from Morris.

Numeral winners are Robert Bonczek, fullback from Barry; Joseph DesMarais, end from Buffalo; Thomas Gullickson, halfback from Middle River; Ronald Kolb, guard from Ortonville; and Lynden Nelson, guard from Sedan. All are freshman students.
