Richard Strauss' tone poem "Allerseelen" (All Souls' Day) as played by the band is the first setting of the piece to be transcribed for band. It was originally composed by Strauss as an art song.

One of the greatest examples of 19th century instrumental music, the Overture to "The Mastersingers of Nuremberg", will be presented on the program by three themes from the Overture.

Selections from "The Water Music" by Handel and "Golliwogg's Cake Walk" by Debussy are also included on the program conducted by Dr. Johnson.

Before joining the UMM music department this fall, Dr. Johnson was associate professor of music and chairman of the department of music at Parsons College, Fairfield, Iowa. He received his bachelor of Music, master of arts and doctor of philosophy degrees from the State University of Iowa at Iowa City and studied for one year in Germany under a Fulbright scholarship.

Tickets for the concert are being sold by band members and will be available at the door Tuesday evening at one dollar for adults and 75 cents for students.
