The curriculum of the University of Minnesota, Morris permits prospective students to begin college classes in the middle of the school year, H. G. Croom, UMM Director of Student Services, said this week in a statement clarifying the recent announcement of winter quarter registration dates.

Former students who have dropped out of UMM classes or out of other colleges and students transferring from other institutions as well as new students who have never attended a college previously may start classes at UMM at the beginning of winter quarter on January 2.

Nearly all credits from other colleges are usually transferable to UMM, according to Mr. Croom, and individual counseling is available to enable transfer students to meld their previous programs with programs available at UMM.

Registration dates for winter quarter classes are December 1 to December 29 for persons not enrolled at UMM at the present time. All registration will take place in the Office of Student Services where counselors are available for any assistance needed.
