The preliminary game was moved to the St. Cloud Tech High School gymnasium and was called when power was restored in the college field house.

The University of Minnesota, Morris cagers lost to the St. Cloud State College freshmen, 74-55 Saturday night after coming within seven points of the visitors during the second half. The UMN basketeers rallied with 10 minutes left in the game, but then over-extended themselves by pressing and fell behind. The Cougars also felt the loss of one of their leading scorers, Karl Keiffer, who fouled out at that time.

Leading scorer in the game was St. Cloud's Seelassen with 33 points, while Dennis Clausen led UMN scoring with 20 points. Clausen has averaged about 12 points per game for the ten UMN games played to date. He has accounted for 118 points so far this season.

Karl Keiffer has made 97 points in the season to date, averaging about 10 per game. John Erickson and Berl Clausen are averaging approximately seven points per game, Stan Anderson 5½ points and Don Sherman 4½ points.

The University of Minnesota, Morris cagers erased a seven-point deficit at the start of their game Saturday night to decisively defeat the Moorhead State College freshmen 69-51 on the UMM home court.

After a faltering start the Cougars pushed ahead early in the first half, pulled steadily away and never relinquished their safe margin. Halftime found the Cougars leading 39-26.

Playing one of their best games of the season, the UMM basketballers made 63% of their free throws and shot at a 52% average from the field, sinking 25 of 79 shots. Stan Anderson captured 16 rebounds for an excellent job in that department.

Leading scorer in the game was Karl Kieffer with 25 points, followed in the scoring column by Moorhead's Bailey and UMM's Dennis Clausen who contributed 18 and 17 points respectively.

The University of Minnesota, Morris cagers will host two visiting teams on the UMM court during the next three days. Tomorrow (Saturday) the Cougars will seek to avenge their earlier loss to the Concordia College freshmen. The UMM-Concordia game will begin at 8 p.m. in the UMM gymnasium.

On Monday, February 12, Fergus Falls Junior College will travel to Morris for an 8 p.m. game with the Cougars. Fergus Falls afforded the University basketballers their first win of the season last December 4 when the Cougars eked out a 58-57 win in overtime.

The Concordia College freshmen defeated the University of Minnesota, Morris basketballers, 91-74, in a hard-fought game Saturday night in the UMM gymnasium. The University Cougars hit well during the first half as the lead alternated between the teams. Trailing by 12 points at one place in the half, the Cougars rallied to within three points of Concordia at ^{halftime} ~~the end of the~~ when the score was 45-42. In the second half Concordia pulled progressively farther ahead to effectively trounce the Cougars.

UMM freshman Dennis Clausen topped both clubs with 25 points, boosting his season total to 160 points for an average of more than 13 per game. Tom Dalen was high point man for Concordia with 19 points. Karl Kieffer and Derl Clausen scored 14 and 12 points, respectively, for the Cougars.

In the free throw circle the UMM eagles sank 65% of their shots, one of their best figures of the season.

Final game of the University of Minnesota, Morris' second cage season will pit the Cougars against a new opponent, the Bemidji State College freshmen. The UMM-Bemidji tilt will start at 8 o'clock Saturday night in the UMM gymnasium.

The Cougars enter their final game with a 4-9 record, but have won three of their last five games. They have averaged 68 points per game in those last five contests.

Seeking to better their season's shooting averages will be the UMM's top scorers who have steadily improved throughout the year. Averaging approximately 14, 11 and 8 points, respectively, per game for the season, Dennis Clausen, Karl Kieffer and Derl Clausen have averaged approximately 19, 16, and 13 points, respectively, in the last five games.
