EVENING SCHOOL COURSES TO BE OFFERED AT UMM

Evening college courses will be offered at the University of Minnesota, Morris for the first time beginning February 6, it was announced this week by Rodney A. Briggs, UMM Dean.

Six courses will be offered during the first 12-week period. Included will be principles of art, a library science course, fundamentals of music, an American history course covering the Civil War, and the inauguration of flight training and ground school.

Faculty for the evening classes will include Dr. Frederick W. Peterson, assistant professor of art; Mr. Donald W. Gray, UMM library head; Dr. Clyde E. Johnson, assistant professor of music; Dr. John Q. Imholte, lecturer in history, and Mr. Donald Uhlenberg.

Meeting once per week for 12 weeks the evening courses will be offered for college credit but may also be audited.

Now in its second year of operation, the University of Minnesota, Morris is beginning its evening program at this time in response to an expressed need for such courses on the part of West Central Minnesota residents. Proposals to inaugurate summer session courses in June are also being studied.
