Season subscribers to the University of Minnesota, Morris Film Series are being reminded this week that the first film in the winter quarter series has been re-scheduled on next Monday, January 29, at 8:30 p.m. in Edson Hall auditorium. It was originally set for January 15.

Opening film in the series is "Panther Panchali", the first part of a prize-winning trilogy filmed in India by a 31 year-old commercial artist. Labeled as one of the finest pieces of filmed folklore ever made, "Panther Panchali" is a complete story in itself. It received grand prizes at the Cannes and San Francisco film festivals, numerous awards at other festivals and was acclaimed "best foreign film of the year" by the National Board of Review.

Following "Panther Panchali" in the winter program are a French comedy, a German drama and a Russian classic, "Ivan the Terrible". General admission tickets for all four films may be purchased for \$2 Monday evening.
