MORRIS, Minn. (12/31/75) -- John Wallace, professor of philosophy at the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities, will address the second annual Midwest Philosophy Colloquium at the University of Minnesota, Morris on Jan. 14.

Wallace, the fourth speaker to address the colloquium this academic year, will speak at 3 p.m. in Science room 150 on "If Language is to be a Means of Communication, there must be Agreement in Judgments."

His 8 p.m. address in the Science Auditorium will be "Conceptual Change in Science: William Harvey."

Wallace received his Bachelor's degree from Yale and his doctorate from Stanford. Before joining the faculty at Minnesota, he taught at Princeton and Rockefeller Universities. He has published papers on the philosophy of language. His work is especially concerned with the theories of meaning.
