### Motor and Motor Control Course

MORRIS (1/21/76) -- Registrations are now being accepted for a 10 session training course on motor and motor controls to be conducted at the University of Minnesota, Morris beginning Feb. 2.

The course is being sponsored by the UMM Office of Continuing Education and Regional Programs, Otter Tail Power Company and the Electrification Council.

Instructor will be UMM faculty member Dr. Som Agarwal, associate professor of physics.

The course, according to Continuing Education Director Roger McCannon, "is designed to deepen the understanding of and appreciation for motors and motor controls in plan, production, maintenance and engineering personnel at all levels."

It places special stress on the relationship of motors to heating and cooling, and on the selection, application and maintenance of motors in the heating and cooling process.

Dr. McCannon said the course will cover basic principles, fundamentals of motors, fundamentals of motor control, single phase motors and control, polyphase induction motors, control for polyphase induction motors, synchronous motors and controls, D-C motors and controls, and maintenance of motors and controls.

All sessions will be held in the UMM Science Building from 7 until 9:30 p.m. beginning Feb. 2 and running through April 5.

Registration is \$35. Credit will be 2.5 Continuing Education Units.
