MORRIS (1/27/76) -- Hector-Neri Castaneda, Mahlon Powell professor of philosophy at Indiana University, will address the Second Annual Midwest Philosophy Colloquium at the University of Minnesota, Morris, Wednesday (2/4).

Castaneda, the fifth speaker to address the colloquium this year, will speak at 3 p.m. in Science Building room 150 on "Reference and Communication." He will deliver a second address at 8 p.m. in Science Auditorium entitled "The Nature of Moral Reasoning."

Castaneda received his PhD from the University of Minnesota in 1954. Before joining the faculty at Indiana in 1969, he taught at Wayne State University, the University of San Carlos, Guatemala, and the University of Minnesota. He has served as visiting professor at the University of Pittsburgh and the University of Texas.

Castaneda has published more than 75 articles in scholarly journals, both in Spanish and English. He has authored a large number of books, the most recent of which is The Structure of Morality. He has also served as editor of the prestigious journal Nous since 1966.

The colloquium sessions are open to all without charge.
