MORRIS (1/28/76) -- Students at the University of Minnesota, Morris will begin sculpting "Dubious Moments in American History" out of snow this week in preparation for a flurry of "Snow Daze" activities on campus next week.

"Snow Daze" will officially get underway Tuesday (2/3) when students will test their talents in the annual talent show at 8:15 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. Entrants will compete for first, second and third place prizes of \$25, \$10 and \$5. respectively. The show is open to the public without charge.

An ice skating party will be held on the rink behind Gay Hall at 10 p.m. Wednesday (2/4), and on Thursday the rink will be the site of a "Name the Lake" tug-a-war," which will determine whether the rink will bear the name of either "Gay" or "Independence" lake, since it is situated close to both of these campus residences.

Broomball tournaments also will be held during the week.

On Friday, (2/6) snow sculptures will be judged at 4 p.m. and a dance featuring "Revelation," will be held at 9 p.m. in P.E. Annex. The French film "Muriel" will be shown in Edson Auditorium at 8:15 p.m.

Saturday (2/7) will be a day of tournaments. At 9 a.m. ping pong tourneys will begin in the P.E. Annex. Competition will be held for both novice and experts. At noon a chess tourney is planned in Edson Lounge, and at 12:30 p.m. the second annual arm wrestling tourney will begin in P.E. Annex. Competition divisions will be determined by sex and weight.

Saturday evening's activities include the bluegrass band, "Monroe Doctrine" in concert at 8:15 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. "Snow Daze" activities will culminate Sunday with a ski trip to Powder Ridge by chartered bus. The trip is sponsored by the UMM Ski Club.
