EDITOR'S NOTE: This is another in the series "This Week at UMM," a continuing pre-view of events on the Minnesota-Morris campus of interest to the public.

MORRIS (1/30/76) — The culmination of "Snow Daze" activities, a Performing Arts Series concert and District 21 high school wrestling tournament are among upcoming events at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

Judging of snow sculptures produced during annual "Snow Daze" activities will be held at 4 p.m. Friday (2/6). This year's theme, "Dubious Moments in American History," was selected in honor of the Bicentennial.

Other "Snow Daze" activities include ping pong, arm wrestling and chess tournaments on Saturday (2/7). Ping pong will begin at 9 a.m. in the P.E. Annex, chess will begin at noon in Edson Lounge and arm wrestling is slated to begin at 12:30 p.m., also in P.E. Annex.

Saturday evening a concert featuring "Monroe Doctrine," a blue grass band, will begin at 8:15 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. There is no admission charge.

Next Tuesday (2/10) internationally acclaimed pianist James Tocco returns to the Morris campus for a concert sponsored by the UMM Performing Arts Series. Tocco returns by popular demand after a sell-out performance last year. Admission to the concert for those not holding Performing Arts subscriptions is \$2.

The District 21 high school wrestling tournament will be held Thursday, Friday and Saturday (2/12-13-14) in the P.E. Center. General admission is \$2 at the gate. Student admission is 50 cents. There will be no reserved seats.
