MORRIS (2/2/76) -- Two physics professors will team up Wednesday (2/4) to present a free public lecture-demonstration on 18th century hand-horn playing.

The event will be at 3 p.m. in the Recital Hall of the Humanities Fine Arts Center. It is open to everyone, and there will be no charge.

The lecture, entitled "A Physical Study of the Art of the 18th Century Hand-horn playing," will discuss the physical principles of the French Horn.

It will be given by Dr. Peter Roll, professor of Physics on the University of Minnesota's Twin Cities campus. It will be illustrated by several musical examples which Dr. Roll will perform in the 18th century manner accompanied by Dr. Merle Hirsh, chairman of UMM's Division of Science and Math, at the piano.
