Editor's Note: This is one of a continuing series titled "This Week at UMM," a preview of events of interest on the Morris campus of interest to the public.

MORRIS (2/6/76) -- A theatre production of "Our Town," a performance of one of the earliest operas written, an international debate and a gallery opening are among upcoming events at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

The UMM Theatre production "Our Town" will open in the Black Box Theatre of the Humanities Fine Arts Center Wednesday (2/18) with performances each evening at 8:15 p.m. through Saturday Feb. 21. General admission is \$1.50 for adults and \$1 for students. The box office is open for ticket sales, and reservations can be made by calling (612) - 589-2211, ext. 399.

On Thursday (2/19) The New World Consort will present Adam de la Halle's "Le Jeu de Robin et Marion," under the auspices of the UMM Performing Arts Series. The play is one of the earliest examples of secular music theatre and has been called the embryo of opera. The 8:15 p.m. performance will be held in Edson Auditorium. Admission for those not holding Performing Arts subscriptions is \$2.

The following Tuesday (2/24) "Resolved that Women's Lib is Doing More Harm than Good," will be the topic for the International Debate hosted by the Morris Debate and Forensic Association. Sponsored by the Morris Campus Union Board, the debate will feature David Linney and Crawford Falconer of the Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand, who will visit Morris as part of their Spring tour.

Also slated Tuesday at 4 p.m. is the opening of the UMM Permanent Art Collection in the Humanities Fine Arts Center Gallery. The public is invited to attend the opening or view the exhibit during gallery hours, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday. It will continue through March 15.

The UMM P.E. Center will be the site of the Region 6 high school wrestling tournament on Friday and Saturday (2/20 and 2/21). Friday sessions will begin at 11 a.m., and at noon on Saturday with the championship rounds slated for 8 p.m.

Admission is \$2 for adults per session, and 50 cents for students. Some 175 wrestlers from Districts 21, 22, 23 and 24 are expected to participate.
