### ESP and Altered States of Consciousness

MORRIS (2/23/76) -- "ESP and Altered States of Consciousness," will be the topic of a convocation featuring parapsychologist Stanley Krippner Monday (3/1), at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

The 4 p.m. convocation will be held in Edson Auditorium on the UMM campus, and is free and open to the public.

Dr. Krippner, who is currently director of the Humanistic Psychology Institute in San Francisco, has gained world renown in the field of parapsychology, the study of various psychic phenomena, including telepathy, clairvoyance and psychokinesis (the ability to affect material objects with the mind).

Krippner has been involved in research with the controversial Israeli psychic Uri Geller, who is reputed to have exerted mental control over material objects, bending forks, spoons and other metal objects with "mental concentration."

He has conducted numerous scientific investigations in parapsychology and has published more than 250 articles in various scientific journals.

He is the co-author of the book Dream Telepathy (1973) and recently completed another book Song of the Siren: A Parapsychological Odyssey (1975). Other books he has co-authored are Galaxies of Life (1973), The Kirilian Aura (1974) and The Energies of Consciousness (1975).

Krippner has traveled to many locations throughout the world to study and teach. He recently returned from a visit to the Soviet Union, where he conferred with Russian parapsychologists.
