EDITOR'S NOTE: Here is another in the series "This Week at UMM," a continuing preview of events of interest to the public on the University of Minnesota, Morris Campus.

MORRIS (2/20/76) -- A concert, the UMM theatre production "Under the Gaslight," a convocation on altered states of consciousness, and an infant and childhood nutrition workshop are among upcoming events at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

Friday (2/27) A concert by Redwood Landing, a group that combines, rock, calypso, and jazz, will be held at 8:15 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. It is free and open to the public.

Monday (3/1) A convocation on "ESP and Altered States of Consciousness" will feature Dr. Stanley Krippner, at 4 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. Krippner is director of the Humanistic Psychology Institute in San Francisco and is widely known for his research in the fields of parapsychology and psychic phenomena.

Wednesday (3/3) The UMM Theatre production "Under the Gaslight" will open in Proscenium Theatre of the Humanities Fine Arts Center. Performances will begin at 8:15 p.m. each evening through Saturday (3/6). General admission is \$1.50; student admission is \$1.

Tuesday (3/2) and Thursday (3/4), a workshop on infant and childhood nutrition featuring Morris pediatrician Stephen Bergmann and his wife, Verna, a nutritionist, will be held from 7 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. in Edson. The workshop will cover various aspects of maternal, infant and childhood nutrition, tips on buying baby foods and a demonstration of how to make baby food at home. There will be a door prize drawing and free samples of baby food will be available. The workshop is free and open to the public.
