Midwest Biennial Arts Exhibition, Four Morris Artists Selected

MORRIS (3/5/76) -- Four Morris artists have had works selected for the prestigious 14th Midwest Biennial Arts Exhibition at the Joslyn Museum in Omaha, Neb., and one of them has won the "Best of Show" award.

"Cloud Maker's Transit," a sculpture by University of Minnesota, Morris art faculty member Meredith Jack, has earned its creator not only a "Best in Show" award, but also a purchase prize of \$1,000.

Works by John Ingle and Fred Peterson of the UMM art faculty and by Cheryl Robideau of Morris also were accepted into the juried exhibition which opened March 6 to continue through April 11.

An estimated 1400 artists from 16 states submitted entries. This number narrowed to 350 during preliminary judging and eventually to the 100 works which appear in the show.
