MORRIS (4/5/76) -- Registration is continuing this week at the University of Minnesota, Morris for certain Evening Division Spring Quarter offerings, Continuing Education Director Roger McCannon said today.

Some of the courses can be taken for academic credit, and others are non-credit, he said.

Those courses for which late registrations are being accepted include "Principles of Accounting" (6:30 p.m. Wednesday - Humanities Fine Arts 7), "Interviewing and Negotiating" (6:30 p.m. Monday - HFA 26), "Diplomacy" (6:30 p.m. Thursday - HFA 26), "The Campaign and the Candidates" (7 p.m. Tuesday - HFA 7) and "The Metric System" (7 p.m. Monday - HFA 7).

Others are "Literature of the American Indian" (6:30 p.m. Wednesday - HFA 26). "The Bible as Literature" (6:30 p.m. Thursday - HFA 7), "Speed Reading" (runs for five weeks and begins at 7 p.m. Thursday, April 8 in HFA 18), "Public Speaking" (runs for five weeks and begins at 7 p.m. Monday, April 26, in HFA 18), "Drawing" 6:30 p.m. Monday - HFA 135), "Painting" (6:30 p.m. Wednesday - HFA 130), "Ceramics" (6:30 p.m. Tuesday - HFA 145), "History of Women" (6:30 p.m. Tuesday - HFA 26) and "Judo" (7 p.m. Monday - 250 Physical Education Center).

Some of the courses are offered at half price. Others are tuition free to senior citizens, who are admitted on a space available basis, and others are at reduced prices.
