MORRIS (4/7/76) -- David Shwayder, professor of philosophy at the University of Illinois, Urbana, will address the second annual Midwest Philosophy Colloquium at the University of Minnesota, Morris next Wednesday (4/14).

Shwayder, the seventh speaker to address the colloquium this academic year, will speak at 3 p.m. in Science Building Room 150 on "A Semantics of Utterance." He will deliver a second address at 8 p.m. in Science Auditorium on "Philosophy for Practical Reason."

Shwayder received his Doctor of Philosophy degree from Oxford University in England. He has taught at the University of Illinois and the University of California, Berkeley.

His main philosophical interests are in traditional metaphysics, ethics and language behavior. He has produced major publications in each of these areas.

The colloquium sessions are open to all interested persons without charge.
