MORRIS (4/23/76) -- Panayot Butchvarov, professor and chairman of the Department of Philosophy at the University of Iowa, will address the second annual Midwest Philosophy Colloquium at the University of Minnesota, Morris May 5.

Butchvarov, the eighth speaker to address the colloquium this academic year, will speak at 3 p.m. in Briggs Library Room 360 on "Identity." He will deliver a second address at 8 p.m. in Social Science Room 123 entitled "Existence."

Butchvarov received his MA and PhD degrees from the University of Virginia. Prior to his appointment at Iowa, he taught at Syracuse University, the University of South Carolina and the University of Baltimore.

He is the author of Resemblance and Identity: An Examination of the Problem of Universals and The Concept of Knowledge. In addition he has written many articles for philosophical journals. He currently is working on a book which incorporates the topics of his two addresses at UMM.
