MORRIS (4/30/76) -- "Goosebumps," an original musical satire performed by the Dinglefest Theatre Company, is slated Saturday (5/8) at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

The performance is scheduled for 8:15 p.m. in Edson Hall. Dinglefest is a troupe of six young professional performers.

The Dinglefest Theatre Company employs a "Verbatim Technique" in which all of the pieces include direct quotations from popular literature treated in a rapid fire, satirical fashion.

The production relies exclusively on the bodies and voices of the actors to create the properties, the settings and the sound effects necessary for the performances.

"Goosebumps" deals with fear -- rational and irrational -- superstitions and urban paranoia. Individual scenes treat mugging in the park, aging and how to avoid it, government spying, the age-old quest for safety and other topics around the central theme of fear.

Admission is 75 cents for non-students.
