MORRIS (5/6/76) -- The relationship between levels of human awareness and care of the environment will be explored next week at the University of Minnesota, Morris in three programs presented through the "Explorations in Human Consciousness" convocation series.

MONDAY (5/10) at 3 p.m. videotapes on low energy agriculture through utilization of solar energy and wind-generated electricity will be shown in Science Auditorium. Included will be a film description of "Ouroboros South," an experimental energy conserving home built by University of Minnesota School of Architecture students.

TUESDAY (5/11) videotapes on the New Alchemy Institute, a California based organization for experimentation with alternate energy sources, will be shown at 3 p.m. in Science Auditorium. The California institute has worked with methane gas produced from animal waste and homestead sources of electricity from sun, wind and water generators.

WEDNESDAY (5/12) Joel Goodman of the University of Minnesota School of Architecture will speak on "Inner and Outer Development" at 4 p.m. in Edson Auditorium. In the talk he will relate maturation of human consciousness to environmental care and development.

Goodman not only teaches architecture, but is director of the Ouroboros South experiment in energy conserving house designs. He also has traveled in India where he studied yoga. He is interested in the development of environmentally harmonious systems to provide both energy and healthful living space.

All the programs are free and open to the public.
