MORRIS (5/14/76) -- Though summer may mean school's out for some, it also can mean the beginning of new learning opportunities at the University of Minnesota, Morris for others.

This summer courses in economics, anthropology, the history of women, developmental psychology, physical geology, interpersonal communication, literature and philosophy will be offered June 14 through July 16 during the first summer session. All of the courses can be taken for undergraduate credit.

In addition, four graduate level courses will be available during that time period: Curriculum Implementation in Elementary School Social Studies, Chinese Government and Politics, Theories of Learning and The Process of Persuasion.

Two special workshops also provide graduate credit. A workshop in Human Relations July 6-19 will meet from 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and will provide six graduate credits. A second workshop on Curriculum Implementation in Elementary School Reading is offered for three credits Aug. 12, 13 and 16 through 19 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Summer Session II, July 19 through Aug. 20, will include courses in geography, social problems and ecology.

All summer session courses in social science (including economics, anthropology, history, sociology, and psychology) are specially geared to apply to the competency based social science major at UMM which meets the State Department of Education's most recent requirements for secondary social studies certification.
