Robert L. Raymond Awarded Sabbatical

MORRIS (5/24/76) -- Robert L. Raymond, assistant professor of mathematics at the University of Minnesota, Morris, has been awarded sabbatical leave to pursue studies in applied statistics at the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities campus next year.

Dr. Raymond, who holds his doctorate from the University of Minnesota, will spend the 1976-77 academic year at the Department of Applied Statistics on the St. Paul campus.

He not only will participate as a student in the department, but also is expected to take part in seminars, consulting and research.

"This study seems very appropriate because a large part of my duties at UMM has been teaching statistics - and most of my students are interested in applications," said Raymond.

"The opportunity to learn applied statistics is much better on the Twin Cities campus now than when I was a student, and I believe such learning will improve my teaching. I have also had frequent requests for statistical consulting on campus and occasionally off campus; I expect to be much more valuable in that capacity after my sabbatical," he added.

Raymond joined the UMM faculty in 1970. He is a member of the Mathematical Association of America, and the Society of Industrial and Applied Mathematics.
