Works by Henri Tomasi, Henri Vachey Antoni Szalowski, Clyde E. Johnson, Jean Francaix, Arthur Harris and Sergei Prokoviev will be included. The concert is free and open to the public.

Tuesday (6/1) the UMM Student Art Exhibit will open at 4 p.m. in the Humanities Fine Arts Center Gallery. The exhibit continues through June 14 with hours from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday. The public is invited to attend the opening or visit anytime during gallery hours.

At 8:15 p.m. Tuesday (6/1) a movie marathon will be shown in Edson Auditorium. The marathon will feature 10 short films, including cartoons such as Speedy Gonzales, the Road Runner and Bugs Bunny, as well as classics by W.C. Field, the Marx Brothers, Abbott and Costello and Laurel and Hardy. The marathon is free and open to the public.

Wednesday (6/2) the Prairie Poets Association will meet at 4 p.m. in Edson Lounge. Persons interested in poetry are invited to attend and share their work.

Saturday (6/5) the UMM Chess Club will sponsor a chess tournament in Edson Lounge from 8:30 to 11 a.m.

The final event of the school year will be commencement ceremonies Friday June 11, at 8 p.m. on the mall. The public is invited to attend this colorful annual event in tribute to graduating seniors.
