MORRIS (6/21/76) -- Beginning July 1 the University of Minnesota, Morris will charge a minimal fee for recreational use of its Physical Education swimming facilities.

The charge for swimming during the afternoon swimming session from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. is 75 cents. Swimmers arriving after 2:30 p.m. will be assessed 50 cents.

The charge for the evening swim from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. is 50 cents.

UMM Athletic Director Al Molde cited rising costs of maintenance and upkeep as reasons for implementing the facilities use charges.
