A University of Minnesota, Morris sophomore, Dennis Ross of Morris, won fourth place in the 1962 National Collegiate Bowling Championship in Chicago last weekend. Some 200 bowlers from colleges across the nation were entered in the individual match games event. Ross averaged 192 in 24 games during the two-day tournament.

Jim Nixon of the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, won the championship for the third year in a row with an average of 205. Second and third places went to two Notre Dame Students, Bill Lieber with a 200 average and Tom Schroeder with a 199.

Following the qualifying rounds on Saturday, the 16 top bowlers competed in the semifinals Sunday morning. This number was pared to eight in the finals in which each finalist bowled two games against each of the other seven. The games were scored by the Petersen Point System.

Ross was also a member of the UMN basketball team this past year and is the top golfer on the Morris campus.
