Leonard Munsterman, University of Minnesota, Morris junior from Correll, has been elected president of the UMM student government. Named first vice president was Warren Enger, sophomore from Madison. Connie Bunge, freshman from Donnelly, was elected second vice president.

Other officers named include Janet Lawler, junior from Morris, as secretary; Mary Vogel, sophomore from Henning, treasurer; and Gene Olson, Sunburg and Judy Nordly, Graceville, both freshmen, elected members-at-large. Lynden Nelson, Sedan, and Gary Lund, Brandon, both sophomores, were elected representatives to the Student Affairs Committee.

Munsterman was a write-in candidate in the student government elections held April 19, at which a remarkable 80% of the student body voted. When the election results for the office of president proved indecisive, a special presidential election was held on May 1 at which Munsterman polled a majority of the votes.

The newly-elected officers will take office next fall.
