An Appleton High School graduate has been elected president of the student government at the University of Minnesota, Morris.

Leonard Munsterman, UPM junior from Correll, was a write-in candidate in the student government elections held April 19, at which 80% of the student body voted. When the election results for the office of president proved indecisive, a special presidential election was held on May 1 at which Munsterman polled a majority of the votes. He will take office next fall.

Munsterman has served as a dormitory counselor at UMM, is feature editor of the student newspaper and secretary-treasurer of the men's dormitory. He has also been named to the Dean's List signifying high academic achievement.

Other officers elected included Warren Enger, Madison, first vice president; Connie Bunge, Donnelly, second vice president; Janet Lawler, Morris, secretary, and Mary Vogel, Henning, treasurer.
