The University of Minnesota, Morris golf team finished its tournament schedule last weekend with a good showing in two invitational matches.

Dennis Ross of Morris was medalist of the North Dakota Invitational at Lincoln Park Golf Course in Grand Forks on Friday. He came in with a 66, the low score of the day. The UMM team finished eighth among 11 teams, coming in ahead of three four-year colleges--Gustavus Adolphus, St. Thomas and Jamestown.

A very strong field that included such distant schools as Michigan Tech competed in the Bemidji State College Invitational at Birchmont Country Club on Saturday. Fifteen teams were entered with the UMM golfers tied for ninth place, ahead of such teams as Macalester, St. John's, Gustavus Adolphus and St. Thomas.

Making the two-day tour were Dennis Ross, Dave DeWall and Peter Ryan, all of Morris, and Tim Bergien and John Buttz, both of Alexandria. Praising the performance of the team, Coach Don MacRae expressed high hopes for the future of golf at UMM.
