With less than three weeks of school remaining in the spring quarter, University of Minnesota, Morris students are actively seeking summer employment in the West Central Minnesota area. According to Charles C. Hanna, assistant director of student services at UMM, summer work is vital for a great number of college students who depend to a large extent upon employment during the summer months to enable them to continue their college education.

The diversified experience and skills of college students qualifies them for many types of positions, Mr. Hanna noted. UMM students have had experience in clerical and construction work and have served as clerks, waitresses and waiters, photographers, truck drivers, telephone operators, life guards, surveyors, salesmen, painters, machine operators, caretakers, laboratory assistants, nurses aides, projectionists, news correspondents and service station attendants.

Several students have worked in grocery stores and at resorts, golf courses and playgrounds. A large proportion of the students have had extensive experience in domestic work, all types of farm labor and construction jobs.
