MORRIS--James Noehl, a member of the University of Minnesota, Morris faculty, attended a two day conference on methods and problems of instruction in business administration, with a special emphasis on insurance. The meeting was held in Chicago last Friday and Saturday, November 1 and 2.

The two day conference was one of six regional meetings held each year by the American Institute of Property and Liability Underwriters, Inc. College instructors in the field of business from Minnesota, Wisconsin, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri, Iowa and Illinois attended.

On Monday, November 4, Mr. Noehl attended an All-Industry luncheon held in Minneapolis. He was one of 14 Minnesotans presented with the Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter (C.P.C.U.) designation.

Mr. Noehl was awarded this designation by the American Institute of Property and Liability Underwriters, Inc. at their national meeting in September. He was not able to attend the national meeting, however, and the award was given last Monday.

To achieve this designation a candidate must pass a series of five intensive professional examinations and meet other requirements of experience and ethical standing set by the Institute.

This is but one of several awards Mr. Noehl has received. He is a member of Beta Alpha Psi, an honorary accounting society, he has received a Ford Foundation fellowship at the University of Minnesota in the summer of 1962 and he has received a fellowship from the American Society of University Teachers of Insurance.
