MORRIS--Six University of Minnesota, Morris seniors will be playing their final college football game on Saturday, November 2 when the Cougars take on Ellendale State at Ellendale, North Dakota.

Chris Kamrud (#23), Parkers Prairie, has made tremendous improvement this season and played well in the Bethel - UHM game two weeks ago. Chris has been second team fullback most of this season.

Don Sherman (#88), Clinton and Warren Eger (#86), Madison, have been the starting ends most of the season, but Craig Erickson (#84) Morristown, has also seen considerable action at the end spot. Courtland Swanson (#76), Hoffman, and Stan Anderson (#77), Hoffman, have been the starting tackles.

The losses of these young men is going to hurt the Cougars. "Our end and tackle positions are going to be real weak," Coach Dick Borstad said last week.

This has been the first season that there have been seniors on a UHM football team, since this is the first year there has been a senior class at UHM. "I think that the seniors have given leadership to the team, as well as team spirit," Borstad said.

As of Friday, October 24, The Cougars' record was 3 wins and 3 losses. The schedule was against four-year colleges, rather than junior colleges and freshman squads from four-year colleges.
