MORRIS--The University of Minnesota, Morris Cougars will be trying for their fifth victory of the season tomorrow afternoon when they tackle the "Dusties" of Ellendale State College. The game will be played at Ellendale, beginning at 2 p.m.

Six seniors will be playing their final game for the Cougars. The addition of a senior class at UHM in September marked the first time seniors had been members of the grid squad. The six seniors are Stan Anderson and Courtland Svenson, Hoffman, at tackle; Warren Eger, Madison, Don Sherman, Clinton, and Craig Erickson, Morrisville, at end and end and Chris Kamrud, Parkers Prairie, at fullback.

Last year the Cougars dumped Ellendale 41 to 0 for their first intercollegiate football victory. This year's squad at Ellendale has 7 freshmen, 2 sophomores and 2 juniors on the starting eleven. The "Dusties" have also added a new coach, Duane Head, and changed their offense. They play a T - offense with flankers, split ends and use a halfback pass.

Their defense appears to be set up to stop a running game and the Cougars may be forced to go to the air, although they have not used the passing game to too great an extent this season.

On Wednesday the Cougars scrimmaged, putting special attention on their defense. Assistant Coach Satter explained the offensive pattern of Ellendale and the defense was directed at stopping this.

There are two Cougars on the doubtful list for Saturday's game. Steve Chasn, fullback, is still hobbling with a pulled thigh muscle. He will make the trip, but will see limited action, if any. Ricky Smith

suffered an ankle sprain in last week's game against Northland and may not be ready Saturday.

The University of Minnesota, Morris bowling team will compete in its first match of the 1963-64 season on Saturday, November 9 at Coffman Lane at the University of Minnesota.

The UMM bowling team is again a member of the Tri-State Intercollegiate Bowling Conference with LaCrosse, North Dakota State School of Science, Mankato State, University of Minnesota, North Dakota State University, River Falls, University of North Dakota and St. Olaf.

The match at the University of Minnesota is one of three inter-sectional meets in which all conference members compete. There will also be three sectional meets for each conference member. UMM will host one of these on February 29.

A new ruling by the National Intercollegiate Bowling Association will make it difficult for some bowlers to compete on the UMM team. The ruling states that if a bowler competes in a league which pays money or prizes, he cannot compete in intercollegiate bowling.

Coach Dick Borstad said that this would probably restrict some bowlers, who are in such leagues. Any student interested in joining the UMM team should contact Borstad as soon as possible.
