Instructors for the seven evening courses to be offered this fall at the University of Minnesota, Morris have been announced by Charles C. Hanna, co-ordinator for the Morris General Extension Center.

Two members of the UMM English faculty, Patrick J. McGinnis and James C. Gremmels, will teach English 21--Introduction to Literature: The Renaissance and English 56--American Literature I, respectively.

Eugene P. Milstone, assistant professor of sociology at UMM and a psychiatric social worker, will be the instructor for Sociology 53--Theories of Criminal and Delinquent Behavior.

An introductory geology course, Geology 1--Earth Features and Their Meaning, will be taught by Howard L. Stensrud. Donald O. Johnson, a new UMM faculty member and author of a recently-published prize-winning book, will be teaching History 52--History of the Old South.

Dr. Frederick Peterson will teach Art 44M--Oil Painting this fall.

English 21 is a five-credit, semester-length course, while the other five courses carry three credits and run for one quarter. All of the above courses may be taken for credit or may be audited without credit and without taking examinations.

A seventh course, Principles and Practices of Property and Casualty Insurance, is offered under an Insurance Institute of America Program and carries no credit. George Humphrey of Montevideo will be the instructor.

The official registration period for fall evening classes closed on September 18, but registrations are still being accepted. They are subject to a \$3 late fee. These late registrations can be made through the first class meeting on September 23.
