MORRIS--Registration, without late fee, for Evening Classes at the University of Minnesota, Morris has been extended through the first class meeting on Monday, September 23. Charles Hanna, Co-ordinator for the Morris General Extension Center, made this announcement last Wednesday.

This extension will allow registration on the first night of class without payment of a late fee. His office made this announcement to elementary and high school teachers and other ~~interested~~ individuals interested in evening courses at UMM.

The seven courses being offered are Art 44M - Oil Painting, English 56 - American Literature, Geology 1 - Earth Features and Their Meaning, History 52 - History of the Old South, Sociology 53 - Theories of Criminal and Delinquent Behavior, English 21 - Introduction to Literature and an insurance course entitled Principles and Practices of Property and Casualty Insurance.

Each of the classes will meet at 6:30 p.m. Monday evenings; each of them except English 21 will continue for a period of 11 weeks. English 21, 5 credits, will last until January 27. The insurance course doesn't carry college credit and the other 5 courses are 3 credits each.

Registration can be made either today or Monday in the Office of Student Services at the University of Minnesota, Morris. On Monday registration will be taken until the beginning of class at 6:30 p.m.
