MORRIS--The behind the scenes activity and pace is picking up around the UMM campus this week as students prepare for the many Homecoming activities which will begin on Thursday. The first outward signs of Homecoming were the Homecoming buttons which were making their appearance on campus.

Karl Blomgren, sophomore from St. Paul, released a list of tentative plans for the Homecoming celebration. Campaigning for Homecoming Princesses started last week and will continue through Wednesday, Oct. 2. An election for six Princesses will be held Thursday. The students will choose six and from these six will come the Homecoming Queen.

Thursday evening there will be a bonfire and snake dance, beginning at 9:30 p.m. There will be a student mixer after the bonfire in Louis's Lower Level. A student-faculty-Morris businessmen panel will interview the six Princesses on Friday afternoon and select the Queen.

Coronation of the 1963 UMM Homecoming Queen will be held in Edson Hall auditorium on Friday evening at 8 p.m. Another student mixer will be held after the Coronation.

Saturday is the big day of activity for Homecoming. A car caravan will form on campus and tour through Morris at 1:15 p.m. Immediately following, at 2 p.m., the Cougars will host the Braves from Sioux Falls College in the Homecoming tilt on Miller Field. The big Homecoming Dance will be held in the gymnasium on Saturday evening at 9 p.m.
