MORRIS--The UMM'Men's Chorus will make its first appearance of the season at an ABC Rally on the University of Minnesota, Morris campus Sunday, October 20 at 2:30 p.m.

The ABC Rally is being held to point out the need for scholarshind and loan funds for students attending the University of Minnesota,

Morris. The public is invited to attend this event.

The UMM Men's Chorus has already achieved national fame and has become a favorite of west-central Minnesota audiences. Following the chorus, Dr. Elmer Learn will speak on "American Agriculture and the Common Market".

Dr. Learn, head of the Division of Agricultural Economics at the University of Minnesota, gives a very good explanation of the Common Market and its relation to American agriculture. He spent a number of years in Europe aiding the formation of the European Common Market and is aware of every phase of its operation. Don Fredrickson, Murdock, Minn., chairman of the ABC program of the west-central area Farmers Union, will speak briefly on the history and purpose of the Agricultural Barter for College at UMM.

Dean Briggs will characterize those students who have been aided by the ABC Loan and Scholarship Fund at the University of Minnesota and deliver a short address on how ABC fits into the entire operation at UMM.

Coffee and doughnuts will be available in the lower level of Edson Hall following the rally and tours are arranged for those interested in seeing the Morris campus.

The Agricultural Barter for College program is a unique plan of student financial assistance sponsored by the Farmers Union in west central Minnesota in cooperation with the University of Minnesota, Morris.
