Not listed in order of importance.

1. Must be able to gain and maintain the respect of over 100 individual workers of the Union Board. This is of primary importance for the chairman.
2. Must understand and be willing to employ a reasonable hierarchy of authority within the organization.
3. Must have complete understanding of parliamentary procedure committee workings and employer employee, etc. relation.
4. Must be administratively knowledgeable: skilled in decision making; aware of problems in communication and ways to solve them; compromising; public spokesman; coordinator.
5. Must be willing to put Union Board work above all except personal life and academic work.
6. Must have 15 to 40 hours a week to devote to MCUB's work (normally 15 hours).
7. Must have "total programming" concept very much in command.
8. Must be able to objectively view the needs of all different types of members of UMM Community.
9. Must be able to give prestige to MCUB.
10. Must have a reasonably well defined concept of his role and that of other MCUB bodys or individuals.
