September 12, 2011

5. Farah Gilanshah replaces Katherine Benson on Faculty Development
6. David Ericksen replaces Brooks Jessup on Multi-Ethnic Experience

Dave Roberts reported that Pete Wyckoff is willing to serve as parliamentarian just for the September 20 Campus Assembly meeting. Unanimously approved (8-0). Roberts will send out a call for nominations.
