The campus will host nearly 400 prospective students and their families at the tenth annual competitive scholarship event.

MORRIS, Minnesota (January 22, 2016)—The University of Minnesota, Morris will welcome nearly 400 prospective students and their families on Friday, February 5; Saturday, February 6; and Saturday, February 13, at the tenth annual Community of Scholars event. Students from across the country will compete for the campus's most prestigious competitive scholarships: the Prairie Scholars Award and the Morris Scholars Award.

In addition to vying for prestigious awards, candidates will be able to connect with other scholarship finalists; to interact with current students; to engage with faculty, staff, and alumni; and to explore the Morris campus. Students and their families also may take part in tours of the surrounding community.

The Prairie Scholars Award is a full-tuition scholarship package renewable for up to four years. Recipients are selected for their exemplary academic and leadership records.

The Morris Scholars Award includes a \$24,000 scholarship package (disbursed evenly over four years) and a one-time \$2,500 scholarly stipend. This stipend may be used to engage in an eligible scholarship experience such as a research or artistic project, study abroad, or travel to academic conferences during a student's second, third, or fourth year.
