New this season: two festive programs!

MORRIS, Minnesota (November 1, 2016)—The University of Minnesota, Morris is pleased to present its third annual Holiday Soirée. Hosted by the Music Discipline, the event will, for the first time ever, offer two festive programs.

The first program will feature the University Choir, Chamber Singers, and Brass and Wind Ensembles, presenting a varied program of festive music on Friday, December 2, at 7:30 p.m in the Humanities Fine Arts (HFA) Recital Hall. Tickets are available at the door: Adults \$5, Seniors/Children \$3, UMM Students \$1.

The second program includes a festive meal, complete with dinner entertainment by Morris's Blue Note Combo. Following the meal, the Concert Choir will present J.S. Bach's beloved *Magnificat in D* with professional orchestra and vocal soloists. The program also includes two movements from the Rachmaninoff *Vespers* and the Chamber Singers presenting several seasonal selections. *Magnificat* will be held on Saturday, December 3, at 8 p.m. (6:30 p.m. meal), and on Sunday, December 4, at 2 p.m. (12:30 p.m. meal) in the HFA Recital Hall (meal in the Student Center, Oyate Hall).
